BAP Report

There is one additional breeder who submitted fish to the April auction. **Art Herzog** entered three different species, including *Limia nigrofasciata*, the Humpback limia. These entries moved Art above the 300 point level and earned him the **Expert Breeder** award. Congratulations, Art!

Ed Nieves led the way in the May auction with three entries, including the Bronze corydoras, *Corydoras venezuelanus*. PA's own **Tom Gillooly** also chipped in with the Lake Inle Hovering loach, *Petruichthys brevis*.

Veteran **George Savapoulas** was back in the June auction with three entries, among them the African *Tropheus duboisi* (Maswa). **Dr. Paul Loiselle** submitted a vulnerable West African cichlid that is rare in the hobby, *Coptodon discolor*.

George Savapoulas also led the way in the July auction with three more entries, including the Black acara, *Cichlasoma bimaculatum*. Finally, after a lengthy absence from the BAP **Steven Ivanof** submitted a CARES killifish species, *Pachypanchax omalonatus*.
